

### European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) Grade Distribution Tables

ECTS, was developed by the Commission of the European Communities in order to provide common procedures to guarantee academic recognition of studies abroad. It provides a way of measuring and comparing learning achievements, and transferring them from one institution to another.

These statistics are based on final degree classifications awarded to our graduating students over a three year period, and are separated into two groups: School of Performance; and the School of Design, Management, and Technology (DMTA).
